



RESOLUTION 2019-47

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE TESTING AND INSPECTION SERVICES OF CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS FOR THE FIRST RESPONDER HURRICANE SAFE ROOM

WHEREAS, the City of Semmes, Alabama, is required to provide testing and inspection services of construction materials for the First Responder Hurricane Safe as required by FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it would be in the City's best interest and would serve a public purpose to authorize the expenditure of funds to Thompson Engineering to provide these services as required by FEMA.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Semmes, Alabama, while in regular session on the 3rd day of September, 2019, that an amount not to exceed \$9,500.00 is hereby allocated from the Public Safety Capital Fund, expensed from Capital Projects 6830-01 First Responders Safe Room for the purpose of funding the testing and inspection services as required by FEMA to Thompson Engineering.
