National Career Shadow



Be involved. Make a difference. Open doors. Inspire minds. Change a life.

Career Shadowing is designed to help students explore a field of interest while building their understanding of workplace practices and culture. A Career Shadow typically occurs over most of the workday, is conducted at the workplace, and provides the opportunity for the student to ask questions.

We are asking local businesses to host students one day during the month of February. If you host, you choose the time and number of hours the student spends at your workplace; however, we ask that you keep it within school hours: 7:30 a.m. until 3:00 p.m.

Make the most of the experience!

Not sure what you would do? Here are a few suggestions for the Career shadowing experience.

PLAN A VIRTUAL MEETING

Before the Career shadowing day, you may want to set up a virtual meeting or phone call to introduce yourself and give the student insight for the day such as business location and parking, appropriate attire, necessary materials, etc.

EXPLAIN REQUIREMENTS

Take time to explain education and/or training requirements students need to secure a Career in the field. Describe the journey to your current position and give suggestions for students to consider as they pursue a career in the field.

PLAN A VARIETY OF OBSERVATIONS

While the student may have a primary person to work with during the shadowing, it can benefit them to observe and discuss with other employees. For instance, an HR representative could review and give suggestions about resumes and interviews.

GIVE A TOUR

At some point during the shadowing experience, larger companies may want to give the student a tour of the facility, introduce employees, and explain each department's responsibilities.

DISCUSS OPPORTUNITIES

Discuss the variety of opportunities available in your field. Explain the different skills needed for various positions and discuss how the student's strengths and interests could best fit into particular positions.

ALLOW PARTICIPATION

Engage the student throughout the day. Consider how the student can contribute to meeting discussions or projects. If they aren't able to work directly with a project, it may be possible for them to complete a simulated project.

SHIP and SMP programs are federally funded initiatives for Medicare beneficiaries, with SHIP (State Health Insurance Assistance Program) offering free, unbiased counseling on Medicare plans, while SMP (Senior Medicare Patrol) focuses on preventing and detecting Medicare fraud, errors, and abuse, often co-located and serving similar populations (aged/disabled) to help them navigate benefits and protect against scams.


